

Daniel 7:23-25 ²³“Thus he said: ‘The fourth beast shall be A fourth kingdom on earth, Which shall be different from all *other* kingdoms, And shall devour the whole earth, Trample it and break it in pieces. ²⁴The ten horns *are* ten kings *Who* shall arise from this kingdom. And another shall rise after them; He shall be different from the first *ones*, And shall subdue three kings. ²⁵He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, Shall persecute the saints of the Most High, And shall intend to change times and law. Then *the saints* shall be given into his hand For a time and times and half a time.

- What does it mean that he tries to change times and law?
- What is a time, times, and half a time?
- What are the characteristics of the little horn?

10 Characteristics of the Little Horn

1. A **LITTLE** horn (king)
2. Comes up from **AMONG** the 10 horns
3. 3 horns **PULLED**
4. **EYES** and a **MOUTH** speaking great
5. Speaks out **AGAINST** the Most High
6. Arises **AFTER** the 4th Kingdom and **AFTER** the 10 horns
7. **DIFFERENT** from the other horns
8. **PERSECUTES** the Saints
9. Intends to make alterations in **TIMES** and **LAW**
10. **SAINTS** given into his hand for a **time, times, and 1/2 time**

A horizontal timeline from 600 B.C. to 'Today'. Key events include: 600 B.C. (Gold, Silver, Iron), 330 B.C. (Babylon), 312 A.D. (Constantine the Great's victory at the Milvian Bridge, Edict of Milan), 313 A.D. (Edict of Milan), 325 A.D. (Council of Nicea), 380 A.D. (Edict of Thessalonica), 439 A.D. (Theodosian Law Code), 476 A.D. (Fall of Rome), 528 A.D. (Justinian's Code), 500 A.D. (Religious Wars, 'Idols Removed'), 528 A.D. (Vandalic), 529 A.D. (Catholics), 529 A.D. (Catholics), 529 A.D. (Catholics). The timeline is divided into 'Rome' and 'Europe'.

Daniel 7:26-28 ²⁶But the court shall be seated, And they shall take away his dominion, To consume and destroy it forever. ²⁷Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him. ²⁸"This is the end of the account. As for me, Daniel, my thoughts greatly troubled me, and my countenance changed; but I kept the matter in my heart."
