



Overview

- Written by Luke – one of the earliest Gentile converts to Christianity
- Presented Gospel Message without altering it to fit cultural differences
- The visitors converted at Pentecost did not want to leave the church in Jerusalem
- Covers about 30 years from the day of Pentecost to the first imprisonment of Paul

▼ Acts 1:4-5 **And being assembled together with them, He commanded them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the Promise of the Father, "which," He said, "you have heard from Me; <sup>5</sup>for John truly baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit not many days from now."**

- What is the responsibility that comes with receiving the Holy Spirit?

▼ Acts 1:6-8 **<sup>6</sup>Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, "Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?" <sup>7</sup>And He said to them, "It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority. <sup>8</sup>But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."**

- What did Jesus instruct the disciples about restoring the kingdom?
- What is the purpose of the Church?

▼ Acts 1:9-11 **<sup>9</sup>Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was taken up, and a cloud received Him out of their sight. <sup>10</sup>And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as He went up, behold, two men stood by them in white apparel, <sup>11</sup>who also said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand gazing up into heaven? This same Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will so come in like manner as you saw Him go into heaven."**
