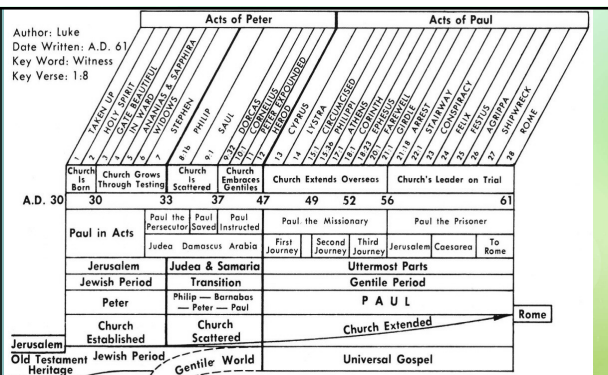

Acts 2:36-37 ³⁶"Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ." ³⁷Now when they heard *this*, they were cut to the heart, and said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Men *and* brethren, what shall we do?"

- What is the summary of this sermon in verse 36?
- What does it mean to be cut to the heart?

Acts 2:38-41 ³⁸Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. ³⁹For the promise is to you and to your children, and to all who are afar off, as many as the Lord our God will call." ⁴⁰And with many other words he testified and exhorted them, saying, "Be saved from this perverse generation." ⁴¹Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to *them*.

- What 2 things were they told to do?
- Is repentance a feeling word or fear of consequences?
- Where would they be able to baptize 3000 people?
- Why was the concept of baptism radical for the Jews?
- Do you have to be baptized to be saved according to Acts 2?
- Who is included in "those who are far off"?

Acts 2:42-45 ⁴²And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers. ⁴³Then fear came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were done through the apostles. ⁴⁴Now all who believed were together, and had all things in common, ⁴⁵and sold their possessions and goods, and divided them among all, as anyone had need.

- What transition occurs between verses 41 and 42?
- What is "the breaking of bread"?
- What 4 tenants founded the original church?
- Are we to continue in the apostles' doctrine when they have been gone for almost 2000 years?
- Why do we require fellowship?
- Are we called to sell everything to give everyone who is in need?

Acts 2:46-47 ⁴⁶So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart, ⁴⁷praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

- What does it mean that they ate their bread with gladness and simplicity of heart?
- What would happen if we followed this model exactly?
- How do we know God is working in us?
