


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Acts 11:4-10 ⁴But Peter explained *it* to them in order from the beginning, saying: ^b'i was in the city of Joppa praying; and in a trance I saw a vision, an object descending like a great sheet, let down from heaven by four corners; and it came to me. ^{BW}hen I observed it intently and considered, I saw fourfooted animals of the earth, wild beats, creeping things, and birds of the air. ²And I heard a voice saying to me, "Rise, Peter; kill and eat. ³But I said, 'Not so, LordI For nothing common or unclean has at any time entered my mouth. ³But the voice answered me again from heaven, 'What God has cleansed you must not call common. ³Dow this was done three times, and all were drawn up again into heaven.

Moreover these six brethren accompanied me, and we entered the man's house. ¹³And he told us how he had seen an angel standing in his house, who said to him, 'Send men to Joppa, and call for Simon whose surname is Peter, ¹⁴who will tell you words by which you and all your household will be saved.'

• We are told that Cornelius was devout. Of what would he have to repent?


Acts 11:15-18 ¹³And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them, as upon us at the beginning. ¹³Then I remembered the word of the Lord, how He said, 'John indeed baptized with water, but you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit. ¹³If therefore God gave them the same gift as *He* gave us when we believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could withstand God?¹³ When they heard these things they became silent; and they glorified God, saying, "Then God has also granted to the Gentiles repentance to life."
