John 2:1-2 <sup>1</sup>On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. <sup>2</sup> Now both Jesus and His disciples were invited to the wedding.

- What does Jesus' invitation to the wedding tell us?
- Many people think that Christianity is "no fun". Does having Jesus around spoil a good time?
- We read that Mary was there but why is there no mention of Joseph?

John 2:3-5 <sup>3</sup> And when they ran out of wine, the mother of Jesus said to Him, "They have no wine." <sup>4</sup> Jesus said to her, "Woman, what does your concern have to do with Me? My hour has not yet come." <sup>5</sup> His mother said to the servants, "Whatever He says to you, do it."

- What is the impact of running out of wine at a Jewish wedding?
- Is Jesus' reply to His mother rude?
- What does Jesus telling Mary His time hadn't come but performing the miracle anyway signify?

John 2:6-7 <sup>6</sup> Now there were set there six waterpots of stone, according to the manner of purification of the Jews, containing twenty or thirty gallons apiece. <sup>7</sup> Jesus said to them "Fill the waterpots with water." And they filled them up to the brim.

- What was the function of the water pots on hand at the wedding?
- Why have servants fill the pots as opposed to just speaking the wine into existence?
- What example do the servants give us in responding to God's commands?
- What is the significance of the pots being filled to the brim?

John 2:8-10 <sup>8</sup> And He said to them, "Draw some out now, and take it to the master of the feast." And they took it. <sup>9</sup> When the master of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and did not know where it came from (but the servants who had drawn the water knew), the master of the feast called bridegroom. <sup>10</sup> And he said to him, "Every man at the beginning sets out the good wine, and when the guests have well drunk, then the inferior. You have kept the good wine until now!"

- ▀ What was the risk taken by the servants in obeying and taking the wine to the master?
- ▀ Of what, is this miracle an example?
