John 20:11-13 But Mary stood outside by the tomb weeping, and as she wept she stooped down *and* looked into the tomb. And she saw two angels in white sitting, one at the head and the other at the feet, where the body of Jesus had lain. Then they said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him."

John 20:11-13

- ▀ Was Mary expecting Jesus to be resurrected?
- ▀ Who is the "they" in they have taken the body?

John 20:14-18 Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, "Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away." Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which is to say, Teacher). Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.'" Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and *that* He had spoken these things to her.

- In Luke, we are told of Jesus walking on the road to Emmaus with two of His believers. How did they come to know this person walking with them over several miles was Christ?
- Why does Jesus tell Mary to stop clinging to Him?
